What breaks trust?

- Broken promises

- Unrealistic deadlines and poor communication
- A culture where speaking up feels risky so staying quiet is safer

When trust breaks down, people stop sharing concerns, safety issues go unreported and teams fracture.

Trust isn't built overnight. It's built brick by brick, conversation by conversation.

So, what builds trust?

- Leaders who show up authentically and follow through
- Open, honest conversations especially when things are tough
- Consistent respect and fairness
- Prioritising wellbeing, not just productivity
- Creating spaces where every voice matters

Why does trust matter so much?

Because without it, people don't just work side by side they survive side by side and survival mode kills creativity, wellbeing and progress.

When trust exists, teams are safer, more resilient and more connected.

Building trust starts with one thing: **Listening.**

Not just hearing words but truly listening to understand. When someone speaks up, respond with curiosity, not judgement. When leaders listen, they create space for honesty and healing.

Building trust won't fix everything overnight.

But it's the foundation we need to start rebuilding the future of construction together.
